Eden Project Race to Zero Carbon Plan.

Aim: To be climate positive by 2030

Current Picture:

- 100% electricity generated via off-site renewables
- Transport fleet run on electric
- 10,000 tonnes of carbon locked up in the soil made to grow our plants
- 85% catering supplies sourced locally

Direct (accounts for 14% of our carbon emissions): Heating, cooling, moving around

Indirect (11%): Bought electricity

External (75%): Buying in food, goods, materials (includes the CO2 produced in making and transporting things), travel (staff, visitors, suppliers) and building things



GREENING THE ESTATE

Installation of green walls, steps and living pillars completed in 2022. Further transformational changes to achieve increased greening, biodiversity, accessibility, activation and engagement with the docks in and surrounding the Estate in partnership with Eden Project
